WHAT IS PUBLIC HEALTH?

The Three P's

PREVENTION

Prevent diseases and their progression.

EXAMPLE:

Vaccinations, access to preventative services, screening programs.





PROMOTION

Promote healthy behaviors and environments.

EXAMPLE:

Education, health campaigns, physical activities programs.

PROTECTION

Protect the public by creating a safe environment from existing health hazards.

EXAMPLE:

Creation of health policies, emergency preparedness, and communicable disease control.

PUBLIC HEALTH TECH





TELEMEDICINE AND TELEHEALTH

Enables telecommunication of medical, diagnostic, health education, social support, and treatment-related services.

MOBILE HEALTH APPS

Enables phone applications to track health, such as tracking diet, sleep, physical activity.









ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORDS

Enables the collection of data that can be shared across multiple healthcare organizations.

DISEASE SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS

Enables an advanced, continuous, systematic collection, analysis, and interpretation of health-related data.

"THE TERM 'ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE' MEANS A MACHINE-BASED SYSTEM THAT CAN, FOR A GIVEN SET OF HUMAN-DEFINED OBJECTIVES, MAKE PREDICTIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS OR DECISIONS INFLUENCING REAL OR VIRTUAL ENVIRONMENTS."

- NATURAL LANGUAGE PROCESSING (NLP), UNDERSTANDING (NLU), AND GENERATION (NLG): ABILITY TO COMPREHEND, MANIPULATE, AND INTERPRET HUMAN LANGUAGE.
 - EXAMPLE: BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS THROUGH THE SOCIAL MEDIA AND CONSUMER-GENERATED DATA
 - EXAMPLE: ENHANCE COVID-19 VACCINE SAFETY MONITORING USING NATURAL LANGUAGE PROCESSING (NLP)
 METHODS TO ANALYZE MASSIVE AMOUNTS OF FREE TEXT FOR POTENTIAL SAFETY SIGNALS.
- VIRTUAL AGENTS: SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS THAT MIMIC WRITTEN OR SPOKEN HUMAN SPEECH TO SIMULATE A
 CONVERSATION OR INTERACTION WITH A REAL PERSON.
 - **EXAMPLE:** CHATBOTS
- DEEP LEARNING: CAN IDENTIFY DISEASES BASED ON IMAGING AND PREDICT HEALTH STATUS FROM ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORDS.
 - EXAMPLE: DECIPHERING PATTERNS IN MEDICAL PICTURES LIKE X-RAYS AND CT SCANS THAT COULD POINT TO THE PRESENCE OF DISEASE.


